

Crestview Uniform Policy Guidelines

School attire must be conducive to safety, comfort, body coverage, and free from distractions to instructional learning & school activities.

1. **Uniform:**
 - Navy or Khaki pants, skirts, skorts, shorts & jumpers and light blue, red or white tops with collars.
 - Student Council and/or staff will develop School Spirit Days when uniforms will not be required, i.e. Pajama Day, Sports Day.
 - Field trip days are “special dress days” where jeans are permitted with the uniform Crestview shirt.
 - Students who participate in a nationally recognized youth organization will be allowed to wear the organizational uniform on days that the organization has a schedule meeting.

2. **Pants, Dresses, Skirts, Skorts & Shorts (navy blue or khaki)**
 - Must fit the waist and length (belt suggested).
 - No sweat pants (except for kindergartners), overalls or jeans.
 - No belts or chains hanging from the waist or pockets.
 - Pant hems not to extend beyond the heel of the shoe.
 - No torn or ripped pants.
 - Dresses, skirts, skorts & shorts are to be no more than two (2) inches above the knee.
 - It is recommended that girls wearing dresses/skirts wear shorts under their dress/skirt.

3. **Shoes: All students who come to school must be prepared for PE & running.**
 - Tennis shoes are the preferred shoe.
 - Shoes must cover the entire foot - no open toe/back/sides.
 - No skate shoes of any type.
 - No Platform heels or slick soles. Heels not to exceed one inch on any kind of shoe.
 - No boots, crocs (plastic-style shoes) or sandals.

4. **Shirts (white, light blue or red):**
 - Shirts must have a collar and be free of all insignia. T-shirts may be worn if bearing a Crestview School logo or Crestview club or award logo, i.e. Rocket Reader, Battle of the Books.
 - Sweatshirts and sweaters are permitted if they are red, dark blue or white. They must be free of all logos except Crestview School logos.
 - No bare midriffs, exposed undergarments, spaghetti straps, sheer or halter tops.
 - No torn or ripped shirts.

5. **Hats:**
 - Hats are not allowed to be worn indoors.
 - Hats worn outside must be worn in the proper manner.

6. **Make-up/ Hair:**
 - No make-up or eye/face glitter may be worn or carried to school.
 - No finger nail polish may be carried to school.
 - Students who have hair styles that are deemed to be disruptive will be referred to the principal for determination.

Crestview is a uniform school and students are expected to wear the uniform except as spelled out in the Crestview Uniform Policy Guidelines above. Parents seeking a waiver in regard to this uniform policy must meet with the principal. No pupil shall be penalized academically, discriminated against, or denied attendance to school if the pupil's parent chooses to execute this waiver.
